


[1] More and more young people are taking on voluntary work nowadays. Some even travel abroad and do unpaid work for charity or non-profit organisations <u>there</u>. They help to build homes for poor families, teach children, take care of orphans, or help to protect endangered species. There is a wide variety of voluntary jobs to choose from.



[2] A number of charity groups organise educational programmes for children around the world. Many students volunteer for these types of projects. They teach subjects like English and Mathematics to children while staying in their community and getting to know the people and their culture. It is also a great opportunity for them to work and train with local teachers and develop their own skills. It is also a learning experience for both the children and the teacher. "I had just graduated from high school when I volunteered as a teacher in Uganda," said James, a British volunteer. "Leading a class was a challenging experience for me. I was just a teenager and I had no experience of teaching before."

[3] Young people who would like to help in a very practical way can participate in one of the many construction projects. Several charity organisations help build houses or schools for poor children around the world. In the village of Kamakwie in Sierra Leone, for example, a team of young volunteers built a



secondary school for poor orphans. Beth had a similar experience. She said: "My first volunteering abroad was organized by my school. We went to Swaziland for three weeks and a half. It was the first time I had the opportunity to do something important; spending 10 days working in a rural community building a school kitchen for a woman who would cook for the local children."

[4] For people interested in wildlife, conservation groups organise volunteer holidays throughout the world. They can help wildlife research in countries like Kenya and Botswana or protect turtles in Mexico, Zanzibar, or elsewhere. On Redang Island in Malaysia, volunteers come from all over the world to help conserve the endangered green turtle. Participants monitor the turtles that come onto the beach and protect <u>them</u> and their eggs. They also

get to enjoy the beach and even swim with the turtles sometimes.

[5] Volunteers have to be realistic though and understand that they cannot change the world in two or three weeks. To some volunteers, it seems that they are not doing much by helping out for only a couple of weeks. However, thanks to young volunteers, the lives of millions of people around the world are improving.
